Notes:

- These are very commonly used chords, know each interval in the chord
- Once you know the intervals in the chord it becomes very easy to alter voices
(if you know where the 3rd of your chord is, converting a major chord to minor is a very simple operation)
- Use the intervals of the barre form as a framework (7ths are close to roots, 4ths are close to 3rds, 6ths are close to 5ths)
