


Reading Tablature (TAB)






The fret positions are played in sequence left to right



Play the melody below



Measure Lines seperate the music into tempo based segments, this ties to reading rhythms on staff notation. The biggest drawback to tablature is the fact it lacks rhythmic notation much of the time. It is however the most popular form of guitar notation, and is very easy to find for learning music.

(there are versions of tablature that do include rhythmic notation but it is not standard)
